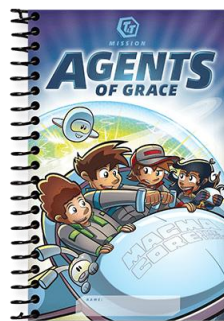
5th-6th grades
